One of the main focuses of the trip will be assisting MCCH Kenyan ministry partners as they finalize details and prepare for the opening of Mescal's Christian Academy (MCA), which may open while Charlotte, Jeff, and Emily are on the ground in Kenya. Our Kenyan ministry partners have done an outstanding job overseeing the construction of the school and collaborating with existing schools to locate and register the most vulnerable children in the community, all while doing their part to create a team of kingdom-focused educators for MCA. In speaking with MCCH Founder and Executive Director, Ruth Owuor, it was determined that the best thing stateside partners could help provide for the summer 2021 partner trip to Kenya would be Bibles!

The heart language for many people in Luanda is Luhya, which led Ruth to determine that providing Bibles in the Luhya language would be the most effective way to give community members access to God's Word. We launched a social media campaign to our stateside partners on Tuesday, June 1st, for what we named "The Bible Project", with a goal of raising \$650.00 to purchase 50 Bibles in the Luhya language. By mid-day on Friday, June 4th, the Lord provided over \$1,150.00 for the purchase of more Bibles than we planned for, including enough funds to purchase new Bibles for Mescal's Kids at the children's home.
